KidzStuff Child Care Center Biting Protocol

Although biting is sometimes a normal method of communication in pre-verbal children, for the safety of our children and staff, all biting is considered unacceptable behavior at KidzStuff Child Care Center.

There are 2 types of biting:

- 1. Play or test biting; this type of biting does not leave a mark or break the skin.
- 2. Aggressive biting: this type of biting leaves teeth marks, cause a break in the skin or draws blood.

If biting occurs:

- 1. Parents will be notified if their child bites or is bitten. The name of the biting child will not be released to the parent of the bitten child.
- 2. The child who play or test bites will be positively re-directed away from the situation. This child will be closely supervised, and behavior will be monitored to prevent further incidents.
- 3. The child who aggressively bites will be removed from the area but will remain under direct supervision.
- 4. The child who is bitten aggressively will receive first aid as appropriate. If the injury requires more than first aid, the parent/authorized individual will be notified to pick the child up and take him/her for care.

Incidents or play or test biting shall be handled progressively as follows:

- 1. 1st incident of biting; parent notification and review of KidzStuff Child Care Center
- 2. 2nd incident of biting; parent notification, review of Rising Sun Biting Protocol
- 3. 3rd incident of biting; KidzStuff Child Care Center's Director/Asst. Director will decide on continued enrollment at the center.

Any incident of aggressive biting will be reviewed by the Center's Director/Asst. Director and a determination will be made about intervention and the appropriateness of the child's continued enrollment at the center.
