Family Activities

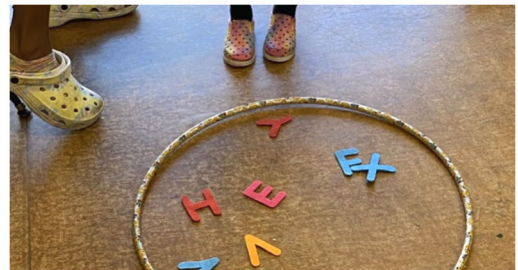
